IBAN is in the format Flxx12345612345678, in which

- FI is Finland's country code
- xx is the IBAN checksum
- 12345612345678 is the basic bank account number, in which the first three digits indicate the monetary institution or banking group. Monetary institution codes beginning with '3' are two characters long, and codes beginning with '4' or '7' are three characters long. Other monetary institution codes have a length of one character.
