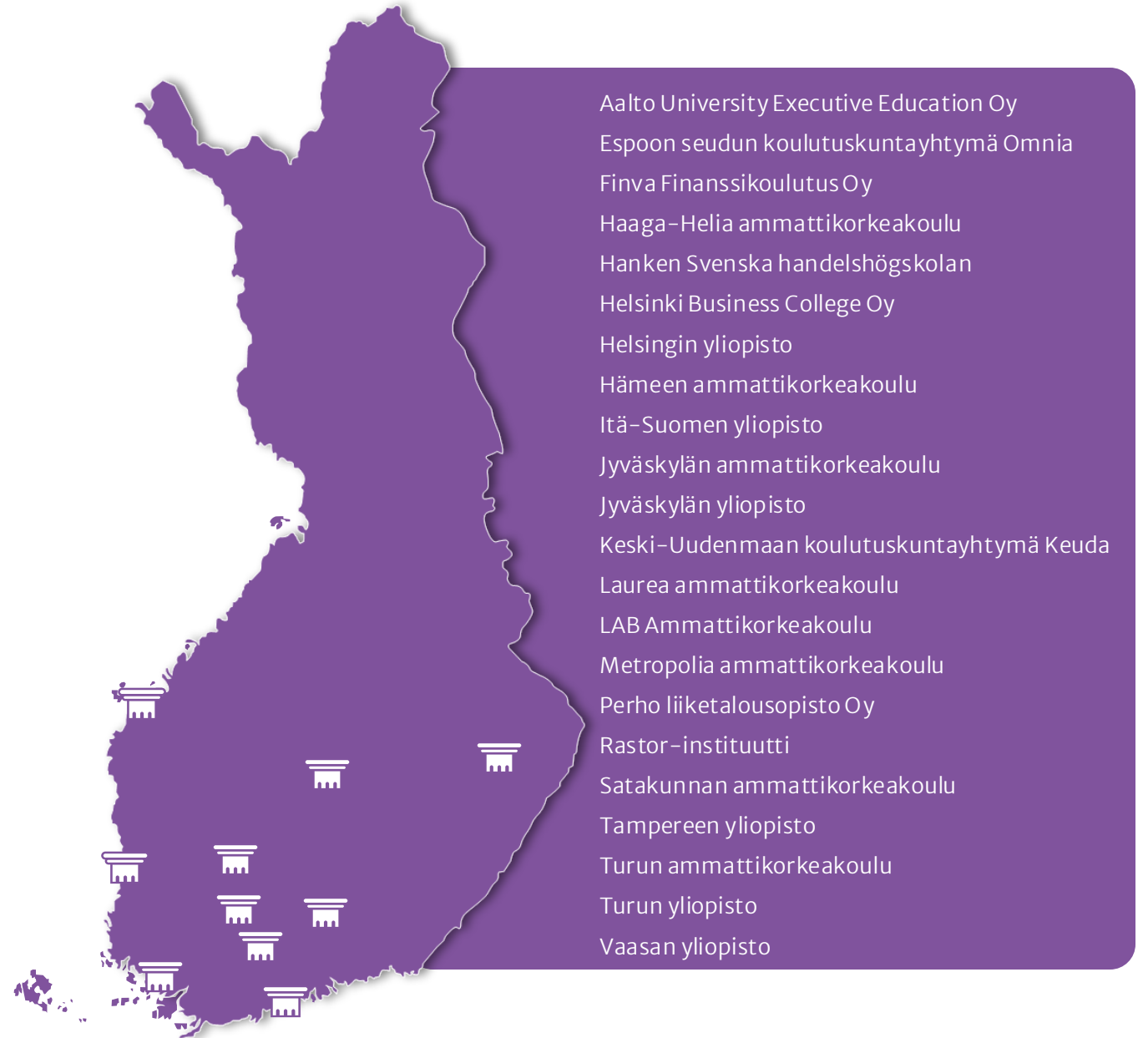


The Financial Academy is a **network** that unites financial organisations and educational institutions. The network's aim is to **share information and know-how** between its members and to increase collaboration between financial organisations and educational institutions to better account for changing needs in the sector. The network also seeks to improve the sector's **employer image**.

The network includes Finance Finland's member organisations and 22 educational institutions.

World's biggest virtual work experience programme

- Was held on 4–8 November
Financial sector's day was Tuesday 5 November, 9.00–15.00
- Participating financial sector companies: **Elo, Ilmarinen, LocalTapiola, Nordea, POP Bank, SEB and Varma.**
- The financial sector's day offered a peek into day-to-day work in the sector. Students were able to learn about the diverse tasks and duties of banking, insurance and pension employees, for example, and heard more about the central role of themes such as responsibility and fraud prevention.
- The next event will be held on 3–7 November 2025.
- Nearly 35,000 students have attended the world's biggest virtual work experience programme.



Financial Academy hackathon

- The hackathon is aimed for students from the educational institutions in the Financial Academy network.
- Hackathon 2025 will be held on **October 2nd** at Nordea's premises. (The 2026 hackathon will be with LähiTapiola.)
- The participating students are assigned group work challenges on an annually changing theme.
 - 2023: Responsibility in the financial sector
 - 2024: Generative AI in the financial sector
- The students workshop solutions to the challenges together with representatives from the educational institutions and Finance Finland's member organisations.
