IBAN is in the format Flxx12345612345678, in which

- FI is Finland's country code
- xx is the IBAN checksum
- 12345612345678 is the basic bank account number, in which the first four digits indicate the monetary institution or banking group. Monetary institution codes beginning with '3' are two characters long, codes beginning with '4' or '71' or '79' are three characters long and from the beginning of the year 2024 codes with '72-78' are four characters long. Other monetary institution codes have a length of one character.
